




The Shadow of the Master **Julius Rooymans** 

10 March - 14 May 2022

Wanrooij Gallery in Amsterdam presents a solo exhibition of the Dutch photographer Julius Rooymans from 10 March until 14 May 2022. The gallery shows with The Shadow of the Master a new series of monumental artworks and portraits. Paintings of Rembrandt, Vermeer and Jan Steen come alive. The layered images, full of scenes and symbolism, reflect the Golden Age in an extra large format.

Artist Julius Rooymans is a passionate storyteller with a fascination for history and large projects. In 2019 he realized the project Nightwatch360 - The Other Side of Art, a photographic reconstruction with lookalikes and a fictitious backside of the iconic painting by Rembrandt, that is exhibited in the Rijksmuseum Amsterdam.

Sony World Photography Awards The World Photography Organisation has revealed the National Award winners for the Sony World Photography Awards 2022. The National Awards program is an initiative set up by the World Photography Organisation and Sony to support local photographic communities around the world, with 61 countries taking part this year.

Over 340,000 images from 211 territories were sub-

mitted to the Sony World Photography Awards 2022 and over 170,000 were entered to the Open competition (from which the National Awards winner was selected). New to this year's Awards is the Latin America National Awards initiative. Set up by the World Photography Organisation and Sony Latin America this new format shines a spotlight on the region's vibrant and varied photographic com-

munity. Looking at talents from across Central America, South America and Mexico the Latin American National Awards rewards first, second and third place and a shortlist of six photographers.

Is an award winning photographer born in Lima, Peru.


He graduated from the Sorbonne University in Paris with a degree in Philosophy of Sciences.

He was nominated "Photographer of the month" by National Geographic France on October 2016.

In 2019 the prestigious German publishing house te-Neues has published a book of his work entitled "Fragile", which received several international awards, among them the 1st prize of the International Photography Awards.






